Farringdon Parish Council meeting - 7th November: Key messages

Planning Application ref: SDNP/18/05327/FUL) was considered at the meeting:

The application is for alterations and extensions to form a kitchen extension, restaurant extension, new disabled entrance and disabled WC at the Rose & Crown. No objection but considerable concern was expressed over the impact this would have on traffic and parking in the immediate vicinity. It was agreed this would be represented to the SDNPA and EHDC in the Parish Council response. The applicant's agent, who was present at the meeting, agreed that measures would be taken by the owner to optimise the use of the existing car park and to install signage encouraging considerate parking.

The following Grants were awarded:

- 1. Farringdon Horticultural Society: £100 for planting around the Parsonage Close telephone box (which houses one of the defibrillators) and the new notice board.
- 2. The Parochial Church Council £400 towards urgent safety related tree felling work in the churchyard.

The draft 2019/2020 financial year budget was reviewed and it was agreed that the Precept (amount to be raised from Council Tax) to be requested of East Hampshire District Council would remain unchanged at £35,000.
